UniSport Australia (UniSport) has the pleasure to invite teams from universities who have membership with CTUSF, to attend a selection of competitions within the 2023 UniSport Nationals.

About Nationals

The UniSport Nationals competition framework is the peak level of intervarsity competition for university students within Australia and combines nine individual National Championship events with one major multisport event (Nationals) each year.

With over 7,000 student-athletes competing, across up to 33 different sporting codes, Nationals provides the perfect opportunity for committed teams to travel to Australia to take part in competitive university sport, expand their social networks and further experience the culture and ambience of the events' host locations.

Member universities are invited to nominate teams to compete within the Nationals in September 2023 and the identified National championships events outlined below.

- Open competitions means that teams can consist of any combination of male or female players
- Mixed competitions mean that there is a specific combination of male and female players required

Nominating teams

Key Dates: Nominations open Monday 1 May 2023 and close on Sunday 21 May at 12:00am midnight (AEST). Team nominations must be submitted in writing by a University staff member/ sports officer and emailed directly to Bianca Bowden (the UniSport Registrations Senior Coordinator) at Registrations@unisport.com.au.

Nominations must clearly outline the following:

- **University Name**
- University staff member/ key contact details (Email, phone number)
- Competitions nominating for (e.g. Touch-Mixed and Womens)
- Entry fee payment method preferred (University to be invoiced OR user pay via the online registration system)
- Statement of team standard: A short narrative identifying the playing standard and competitive quality of each of the teams entered is required.
 - o Nominations will not be accepted from teams that do not present as competitive or only intend on traveling for 'social reasons.' The Nationals are a competitive event, and teams entering need to compete as such.

Please note that all team nominations will need to be formally approved by UniSport following your application.



Entry into the competitions is not guaranteed.

Team management

All teams entered are to travel with a university staff employee to act as an official conduit between the team and UniSport. Teams are to be of a competitive nature and must meet the minimum team numbers outlined in each sport guideline to compete.

Entry fees and processes

Once teams are nominated, there are two ways in which team entry fees can be paid. All fees are to be paid in \$AUD and must be made by electronic funds transfer. <u>Cash will not be accepted</u>. Methods of payment:

- 1. Request an invoice for payment directly by the university. Invoices must be paid prior to competition.
- 2. Pay via the online registration portal as 'user pay' Each participant will be required to register using an online registration portal. Payment can be made through this

Once teams have been nominated, further information regarding this process will be supplied.

Important information about visa's for Australia

All visitors to Australia are required to have the correct visa. You can find out if you need a visa via the Australian Government website – <u>Entering Australia</u>. We encourage every person to read and familiarise themselves with entry requirements to Australia, outlined on the <u>Entering Australia</u> website.

UniSport can provide a letter of invitation to teams wishing to compete at The Nationals however: We HAVE NO influence on the final decision if a visa is granted or not.

We recommend you contact your closest <u>Australia Embassy/Consulate</u> for specific details relating to applying for an Australia visa.

Next steps

If you are a National University Sports Federation, we ask for your assistance to forward this letter of invitation to universities within your country.

If you are a university, and are interested in nominating teams, please send your nominations through as advised above.
